Car Of The Month - June 2021

This is Ed Ferrelli's rare 1986 Pontiac Aerocoupe 2+2 in stunning Silver with 2+2 graphics and gray cloth interior. This special edition Poncho was offered for homologation as an Aerocoupe body for NASCAR competition. The 2+2 specific pieces are the front fascia, rear bubble glass and trunk lid with spoiler. Neath the hood lies a 305 cube block (5.0 L) with four-barrel carb. Tranny is a 200-4R four-speed automatic with 3.08:1 rear axle ratio. At the corners are 15x7 steel Rally II wheels with trim rings mounted on black wall tires. Options on all 2+2's included a/c, power windows, power brakes, cruise, and stereo with Cassette. There were just over 1000 Grand Prix 2+2s built in 1986 at least one of them found a nice home in Massachusetts. In addition to his Aerocoupe, Ed is also the proud owner of a 2000 Trans Am WS6 Convertible.









*Three Deuces and a Four Speed....*Welcome returning member Phil Emmanuel. This is Phil's stunning 1964 GTO in Nocturne blue with blue interior and white convertible top.
