
CAR OF THE MONTH

Club Member John Cooley tells the story of his gorgeous 1983 Grand Prix. He is the original owner.

For 1983 the Grand Prix offered an optional V-8 (1982 V-6 or diesel only), I decided to go for it. In November 1982 I ordered this 1983 Pontiac Grand Prix from Melrose Garage Inc located in Melrose MA. Being 17 and paying for it on my own (and keeping the 1981 LeMans that I bought new the year before), I carefully selected options to keep the price within reason. I spec'd it out as follows: Dark Brown Metallic Paint, Brown Ripple Cloth Interior, 5.0 305 V-8, 2.73 axle ratio (2.29 was std), Additional Acoustical Insulation, Rally Tuned Suspension, Reclining Passenger Seat, Power Windows, Door Locks, Padded Landau Top, Air Conditioning, AM/FM Stereo, Rally II Wheels, Dual Sport Mirrors, Tilt Wheel and a few more options to bring the MSRP to \$11,573. The result was probably the one of the best handling, quietest and quickest stock 1983 Grand Prix's. I took delivery on January 10, 1983 and have had it since. This Grand Prix has been exclusively garage kept. So far it has never been in the rain or snow. The Grand Prix is 100% original, unrestored and just turned 40,000 miles. It holds a special place in my Pontiac collection and has the distinction of being the first of several thousand Pontiac's built to my specifications during the years I managed several local Pontiac dealerships.
